# LUCKY DRAW BACCARAT







# Lucky Draw Baccarat is an exciting variation of Baccarat played against the dealer.

The dramatic increase in popularity of Baccarat over recent years has created a large new player base for casinos worldwide.

Lucky Draw Baccarat delivers a fast paced and fun to play variant that will compliment your games mix on the casino floor.

- Played against the casino plus offers an optional Block Bonus™ side bet
- The player gets to control the action of the game
- Players are dealt a hand that plays against a single house hand played by the dealer
- There is no commission

This exciting development to the game is quick and easy to understand for dealing staff and players. It provides a good return for players whilst still providing a good theoretical edge for the house.

## **Hand Rankings**

The object of the game is to beat the dealer's hand by having a point total closest to 9.

All cards from 2 to 9 are counted at face value and an Ace is counted as 1. Picture cards (Jack, Queen and King) and tens are counted as zero.

When adding card totals together only the right-hand digit will be counted.

Examples: 7+3=0 8+7=5 King+10=0

# **How To Play**

Lucky Draw Baccarat is played with eight standard decks of fifty two cards. Played in a similar fashion to Blackjack, players place a wager and are dealt a hand that plays against the single house hand.

#### Enter Wager

To begin, the player makes an 'Enter' wager.

The dealer will deal a card to each playing area containing a wager and a card to the dealer's position. The dealer will then deal a second card to each of the wagered playing areas

#### **Draw Wager**

The player may stand with their current hand or draw an additional card by making a 'Draw' wager equal to their 'Enter' wager.

After all players have acted on their hands, the dealer will deal a second card to the dealer's position and if his/her two card point count is 4 or less, will draw a third card. The dealer must stand with a point count of 5 points or higher

Wagers are settled as follows:

- Dealer's total is higher than Player's total:
  The Player loses their 'Enter' wager
  and 'his Draw Bet' (if made)
- Dealer's total is equal to Player's total:
  The Player's 'Enter' wager is a push and 'Draw' wager (if made) is a push
- Player's total is higher than Dealer's total: The Player wins and is paid 1 to 1 on their 'Enter' wager
- The 'Draw' wager (if made) is paid according to the DrawWin<sup>™</sup> pay table

### Optional Side Bet: Block Bonus™

Lucky Draw Baccarat offers an optional side bet called Block Bonus™. The player wins if one of their first two dealt cards is of the same suit and of higher rank than the dealer's first card.

Simple to play with odds of up to 35 to 1 - see Block Bonus™ pay table on revere for full details.

# Block Bonus™ Pay Table

Ultimate Block	Two cards of the same rank, higher and both the same suit as the dealer's first card.	35 to 1
Pair Block	Two cards the same rank, higher and one is the same suit as the dealer's first card.	10 to 1
Flush Block	Two cards the same suit and one/both cards are higher and in the same suit as the dealer's first card.	5 to 1
Normal Block	One card higher and in the same suit as the dealer's first card.	2 to 1
